Please find enclosed our 2017 summer contract. For **returning customers the price of \$60/ft. will apply** and for **new customers the rate of \$62 per ft.** for the 2017 summer season will apply. As you might know, Confederation Basin's 2017 price is over \$73/ft. with Portsmouth Harbour being over \$68/ft. If you are returning this summer please submit the form with payment by **March 1, 2017** to confirm your slip. **Please include your e-mail address.** Past year slips cannot be guaranteed after this date. If you know you are **not** returning this season please call, or leave a message to let us know, it would be appreciated.

Parking: As you may be aware, parking, after 30 years of status quo, has become an issue as the city plans to eventually develop Doug Fluhrer Park. We'd like to thank all who spoke to us regarding this issue and will keep you up to date. Please park along the roadway and not on the grass. We are currently working with the city and anticipate no changes.

Insurance: It is the policy of the marina that all boat owners have proper coverage on their boat while at the marina. Proof of insurance will need to be presented before any slips will be assigned. It may also be useful for owners to know if their policy covers oil spills. Please keep your bilges clean as even the smallest of spills can be expensive.

Rules & Regulations: As more people enjoy the marina it is important for all clients and guests know the rules and regulations. Please take time to read the back of the 2017 contract.

MetalCraft Marine: The 2017 MCM year is gearing up to be a full schedule for building fire and rescue boats. Contracts are continuing for 70 boats for the US Navy, fireboats for Charleston SC and Ft. Lauderdale, patrol boats for the Department of National Defense (Canada), a 65ft. passenger boat for Tobermory and three 50ft fireboats for Turkey.

We hope the weather gives us an early start to the 2017 boating season.
