Dear Clients,

Despite early inclement weather and the high water levels, 2017 was another good year for Kingston Marina, and we hope that 2018 will bring a busy season too.

### Spring/ Summer 2018

Please find enclosed our 2018 Summer Season contract. Prices this year have had to respond to the increased costs of minimum wage, and City parking costs. Nonetheless, we have made efforts to keep increases to a minimum, and certainly to remain competitive with other Marinas and Yards.

The price per foot for a summer slip for 2018 will remain \$62.00 per foot. New customers will pay an admin fee of \$60.00. We have added a parking surcharge of \$100.00 per boat, for one car.

If you will be returning, please submit your form with full payment by **March 15th 2018** to confirm your slip. Past year slips cannot be guaranteed after that date. If you know that you will **not** be returning to KM for this season, please can you let us know by email (preferably), or by phone. That will be appreciated.

**Parking:** - 2017 was a difficult year for parking and thank you all for your patience and forbearance. Parking will be more organised this year.

As described above, parking will be charged at \$100.00 for the season per vehicle per vessel. Additional vehicles, may be parked at the seasonal, weekly or daily rate)

**Insurance:** Marina policy requires that all boat owners have proper coverage on their boat at all time whilst their boat is at the Kingston Marina. Proof of insurance will be required before slips are assigned. Owners should check that their policy covers oils spills. As previously reminded, please keep your bilges clean as even small spills are expensive and we are required to respond to them, if seen.

**Staying aboard boats whilst in the yard:** Please note that this is now specifically forbidden as part of MetalCraft Marine's insurance policy, and so is no longer permitted, even for short term.

**Rules and Regulations:** Please refer to these as we enter the season.

**MetalCraft Marine:** Again, MCM is looking to a full schedule of build and deliveries through 2018. The company has a healthy order book of Fire, Rescue, Utility Work & Patrol boats, and a good enquiry/ pending list. Both 349 & 347 Wellington workshops are in full production.

As a note - please take great caution when around the yard, there is a lot of activity of trucks, vehicles & boats.

We wish you all a great 2018 season and look forward to seeing you afloat soon.
